Five College Learning in Retirement

The 5CLIR council met on June 14, 1991 at four o'clock at the home of the President. Members present were Gibson, Reid, McAfee, Swanson, Lieson, Rapoport, Friedman, Kaufman, Keating, Southworth.

Previously circulated minutes of the last council meeting, having been reviewed and corrected, were accepted. The treasurer's report, a detailed explanation of current year expenditures, past year estimated budget and 1991-92 year budget estimate, was endorsed by the council, with corrections entered.


The executive officer Reid was instructed by the president to circulate to the membership in August 1991 copies of the 5CLIR by-laws as amended in May 1991.

Swanson reported conversations he had conducted with the board of Applegate Retirement community concerning consideration of the availability for use of LIR of the structure presently used as a model apartment for the Applegate development. The president instructed Swanson, Reid to meet with Jean Stabell to discuss and seek her advice concerning exploring this issue; President Gibson will join in the discussions.

Kaufman, chair of curriculum committee, reported that early registration for Fall 1991 seminars resulted in 60 paid memberships; all seminars except one (Keating's LOOKING AT ART) have space remaining; 86 seminar spaces have been reserved. Regular registrations are expected commencing August 15.

Keating, chair of membership committee, summarized the membership committee's discussions having to do with possible modification of future seminar registration procedures; the membership committee may develop a recommendation, some time in the future, for the council's consideration

The meeting was adjourned at five o'clock. Nancy and Bill Gibson hosted a reception for the council members and their guests, and during this time joyously we toasted the 50th wedding anniversaries of the Keatings and of the Swansons, and the birthday of Harvey Friedman; great fun.
